## **Launceston Airport - Car Parking Terms and Conditions**

All parking in the Launceston Airport Car Park (**Car Park**) is regulated in accordance with the *Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations 1997* (Cth) and the *Airports Act 1996* (Cth). Cars may only be parked in the Car Park within the marked bays.

Public car parking is prohibited in all other areas, including kerbside at the Launceston Airport Terminal.

Kerbside drop off and pick up is only permitted within the sign posted area in the front of the Terminal building.

Vehicles must not remain in the sign posted area for longer than two minutes and must not be left unattended.

Launceston Airport reserves the right to issue an infringement notice under the *Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations 1997* (Cth) and where necessary, move any vehicle for operational, safety or security reasons.

## By entering the Car Park at Launceston Airport, you acknowledge and accept that these conditions of use of the Car Park apply:

- a) If you do not accept these conditions, you must immediately remove your vehicle from the Car Park and you will not be charged a parking fee;
- b) You must comply with these conditions and all rules and directions displayed in the Car Park;
- c) You will comply with all lawful directions and requests made by a Launceston Airport employee, including the provision of your full name and address in certain circumstances (including where you fail to make full payment of your parking fee on exit of the Car Park);
- d) You are liable to pay the applicable parking fee via one of the payment methods available (including credit/debit card, Apple Pay, Google Pay or in cash) calculated by licence plate recognition cameras or through the use of a paper ticket, applying the rates notified by Launceston Airport prior to your entry into the Car Park;
- e) You consent to Launceston Airport collecting your vehicle's licence plate registration number using licence plate recognition cameras, and using this information for the purpose of calculating the time spent within the car park and the applicable parking fee and for the purpose of issuing infringements in the event of a non-compliance by the you with these conditions;
- f) Launceston Airport reserves the right to refuse entry to the Car Park to any vehicle that does not possess an unobstructed visible licence plate;
- g) Launceston Airport reserves the right to charge the maximum fee to you if you attempt to exit the Car Park without an unobstructed visible licence plate;
- h) You and your vehicle's occupants enter and use the Car Park at your own risk. Launceston Airport shall not be liable to any person, including the owner/driver, for any loss or damage to any vehicle, its contents or any direct or indirect loss consequent thereon, except to the extent that such loss or damage is caused or contributed to by Launceston Airport or its employees or agents;
- You are liable for any damage caused by you or your vehicle to the Car Park or to any property of Launceston Airport;
- j) Any notice to be served on the owner/driver of a vehicle shall be sufficiently served if sent by prepaid post to the address of the owner, as shown in the relevant State or Territory register of motor vehicles;
- k) Any vehicle that remains in the Car Park for a period longer than 90 days without the express written consent of Launceston Airport will be moved, and after a further 90 days will be deemed abandoned if its driver cannot be found after such inquiries are made by an authorised person as are reasonable in the circumstances;

- I) For any vehicle deemed abandoned, Launceston Airport may exercise the right of sale in accordance with the *Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations* 1997 (Cth);
- m) If Launceston Airport does not exercise their right of sale, any abandoned vehicles left in the Car Park will be reported to the Police, removed from the Car Park and subsequently disposed of;
- n) Nothing in these conditions is intended to have the effect of excluding, restricting or modifying the application of all or any of the provisions of Schedule 2 to the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth) (the Australian Consumer Law), or the exercise of a right conferred by such a provision, or any liability of Launceston Airport in relation to a failure to comply with a guarantee that applies under the Australian Consumer Law to a supply of goods or service; and
